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ASVAPP is a non profit organization founded in 1997 with the explicit mission of advocating and applying a rigorous approach to evaluation, in particular to impact evaluation, following the anglo-saxon tradition of program evaluation. ASVAPP pursues its mission through three type of activities: (i) organizing training courses on evaluation; (ii) contributing to the methodological development through dissemination; (iii) conducting selected evaluation analysis of public policy interventions.

At national level ASVAPP developed a number of steady collaborations with legislative, administrative, philanthropic and research organisations. On the legislative side, Progetto CAPIRE has been developed to support the Italian Regional Assemblies to achieve rules, methods and professional evaluation expertise for an effective legislative oversight (www.capiire.org). On the philanthropic side, the continuous collaboration with banking foundations led to define an evaluation framework developed with the *Associazione delle Fondazioni di origine bancaria del Piemonte*. Eventually, on the dissemination side, ASVAPP promoted the IPSEE project (www.ipsee.info) supported by both banking foundations and public research institutions.

At European level, a partnership with the *DG for Regional and Urban Policy* (European Commission) has been devoted to rewrite and edit the impact evaluation section of "The Resource for the Evaluation of Socio-economic Development" (EVALSED guide); in collaboration with DG Regio a Summer School on *Counterfactual Impact Evaluation* devoted to researchers and administrators from European institutions has also been organised. In recent years *DG Employment, Social Affairs and Inclusion* (European Commission) funded three experimental evaluations (Randomized Controlled Trial) of social policy innovation promoted by ASVAPP.

The following is a selection of the most recent evaluation studies conducted by ASVAPP.

Ongoing projects

- *Accompagnamento alla Valutazione per le Fondazioni* – A project targeted to the regional banking foundations of Piemonte providing specific evaluation capacity building. Three are the main activities: (i) design impact evaluations of policy interventions, (ii) provide evaluation training, (iii) organise dissemination events and workshops. [Since 2019]
- *IPSEE - Inventario dei Problemi, delle Soluzioni e dell'Evidenza sugli Effetti* - A web based project for the review and dissemination of evidence based studies in order to share the available knowledge on “what works and what does not work” as a solution for different public policies. The project is sponsored by Banca d'Italia, Compagnia di San Paolo, Fondazione CRT and INAPP. [Since 2016]
- *CAPiRe* - Progetto CAPiRe has been developed to support the Italian Regional Legislatures to achieve rules, methods and professional evaluation expertise for an effective legislative oversight (www.capire.org); the project provides training and dissemination activities and is funded by the *Conferenza dei Presidenti delle Assemblee Legislative delle Regioni e delle Province Autonome*. [since 2002]
- *Insieme verso il futuro* – The non-profit association Il Nostro Pianeta, in collaboration with other non-profit partners, is implementing the project “Insieme Verso il Futuro”, funded by the Department for Family Policies - Presidency of the Council of Ministers. ASVAPP has been commissioned for the monitoring and evaluation activities of the project, including the definition of the indicators set, the tools for data collection from the implementation process, and the analysis of the collected data. [2024-25]
- *AUDE* – The municipality of Torino, in collaboration with Fondazione per la Scuola and Associazione Giovanile Salesiana, is implementing the A.U.D.E.! (Urban Digital Educational Workshops) project, funded by the Department for Family Policies - Presidency of the Council of Ministers. ASVAPP has been commissioned for the monitoring and evaluation activities of the project, including the definition of the indicators set, the tools for data collection from the implementation process, and the analysis of the collected data. [2024-25]
- *Educazione civica a teatro* - The Garrone Foundation supports a civic education project within lower secondary schools. The project is based on the use of expressions and forms of art, particularly theater, and the educational program "Philosophy for Children," as a tool to raise awareness of citizenship and inclusive language. ASVAPP conducts an impact evaluation on the beneficiaries, and an assessing analysis of the perceptions for teachers and school administrators. [2024-25]
- *Sosteniamo le Famiglie* - The CRT Foundation funds projects to support the inclusion of people with disabilities through the "Support Families" competition. ASVAPP provides monitoring support and implementation analysis, including feedback from the beneficiaries of the interventions. [2024-27]
- *Tutti Inclusi* - Tutti Inclusi is a call for projects from the social enterprise Con i Bambini, focused on interventions aimed at improving the inclusion and everyday life of kids with disability and of their families. Twenty-five projects have been selected and financed. ASVAPP designed and is in charge for their impact evaluation. [2024-29]
- *Provaci Ancora Sam* – A project funded by Fondazione per la Scuola, since 1989, aimed at schools in Torino with the goal of promoting inclusion and educational success for the students, and preventing school dropout. ASVAPP oversees the implementation analysis and the impact evaluation of the project. [2024-25]
- *Communal Living* - A project by the Municipality of Cuneo and financed through the fund of the Social Innovation Program (FIS) of the Presidency of the Council of Ministers. It implements integrated forms of living - such as social housing, co-housing, and home sharing - as well as domiciliary services and independent living services to increase the level of inclusion and

individual well-being. The project also aims to experiment Pay By Result financial instruments, through the Social Impact Bond model. ASVAPP, as an external evaluator, is validating the monitoring system, the indicator plan, and verifying the achievement of the expected results. [2022-2025]

- *Cottino Social Impact Campus* – L'ASVAPP supports Fondazione Cottino for the "Development of a model for measuring the economic impact of real estate assets and urban redevelopment in the city of Torino". [2024]
- *Regione Piemonte - Bando disabili* - ASVAPP provides for the monitoring system, implementation analysis and impact evaluation, of some regional policies for employment inclusion of people with disabilities. The contract is part of the Technical assistance service 2021-2024 for Regione Piemonte, in partnership with IS-LM s.r.l. and Fondazione Brodolini. [2024-2026]
- *Research – INAPP*: INAPP and ASVAPP collaborate on two research projects, respectively focused on the impact evaluation of i) the use of smart working in the Italian public sector and ii) the use of "digital platforms" of Italian firms. The collaboration also involves dissemination activities on the impact evaluation of public policies [2024-2025]
- *Training – INAPP*: ASVAPP designs and realises an ad hoc training course for INAPP researchers on policy evaluation topics. The course focuses on the main objectives and approaches of public policy evaluation, discusses its methods and provides application examples. [2024]
- *FRES* - ASVAPP has been awarded with a grant by the Ministry of University and Research (MUR) for 2022 to realise a research on smart working. The research was focused on small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) during (and after) the health emergency from COVID-19 and investigated the implementation and the perceived effects, collecting primary and secondary data. - *Povert  educativa, una mappatura degli interventi* - Educational poverty is the condition in which a child/adolescent is deprived of opportunities to learn, experience and develop skills. Recently, the attention on this problem has gradually increased, and public policies have been promoted. ASVAPP, on behalf of the Consulta delle Fondazioni di origine bancaria del Piemonte e della Liguria, mapped the interventions to contrast educational poverty in the territory of Piemonte, Liguria and Valle d'Aosta. [2023-2024]
- *Fondazione Edoardo Garrone* – Is an ETS Philanthropic Body starting a review of the monitoring and evaluation tools applied to its projects. ASVAPP, in collaboration with Fondazione Collegio Carlo Alberto, supported the Foundation in this early process of capacity building. [2023-2024]
- *Motovelodromo* - The "Fausto Coppi" Motovelodromo is a sports facility in Torino, completely renovated and expanded in 2022 with the support of Fondazione Compagnia di San Paolo. ASVAPP was commissioned to study the impact on residents, and realised an impact evaluation of the initiatives for the promotion of sports among students. [2023-2024]
